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SUBJECT: ACTIVE PHARMACY LICENSE

As an admissions requirement for all applicants and for current students to remain enrolled, the Distance Degrees and Programs (DDP) requires an active, professional US or Canadian pharmacy license for North American-Trained PharmD (NTPD) students; a license or official documentation of the ability to practice pharmacy in the student's respective country for International-Trained PharmD (ITPD) students. All applicants and current students are required to inform the DDP Office of any changes in their license status, such as expiration, suspensions, restrictions, and/or the receipt of any letters of admonition. All students should provide proof of updated licensure upon licensure renewal. Failure to successfully maintain your license or notify the DDP Office of any changes to your license will lead to disciplinary sanctions up to and including to dismissal from the program.
